Estimated Tour Cost:

\$3500 per student (approximately), based on **minimum 20** paying students

Passports

- Each member of the tour must have a valid passport.
- Passports must not expire within 6 months of the date of return (Indonesian law)
- A colour photocopy of the details page of each member's passport will be required and kept at the college whilst travelling
- If travelling on anything other than an Australian passport please advise the school before paying your deposit



Spending money:

- Students will need to take enough spending money to cover meals / snacks not already covered in the itinerary along with any personal expenses (souvenirs, drinks, etc.)
- Suggested amount-\$200-\$250 AUD
- Australia Post VISA Cash Card



Baggage and Packing

- Maximum check in luggage weight 23kg
- Maximum carry-on luggage weight 7kg restrictions to the carry-on of liquids, sharps and flammable items
- All Students must be able to manage their own bags – no porters have been included in this cost.



Staying in Touch with home:

- Mobile phones overseas use is expensive, check with your provider re: rates. Check re: prepaid phones and ability to roam internationally
- Phone cards purchased in Country used to phone back to Australia
- Telstra / Optus international home link account
- Email the cheapest and best way to stay in touch
- Snap chat/ Twitter/iMessage/WhatsApp/ Facetime





Student Requirements:

- Students need to make contact with their homestay family via social media prior to the tour (at least three months prior to begin building a relationship with the homestay family).
- Students use photos from the tour to create a coffee table book for their families and the College library
- Students use live footage and photos to create a film of the tour to share with the families at the family dinner
- Parent Dinner Students to cook a traditional Indonesian dinner as a thank you
