Dear Parents/Carers,

This is a friendly reminder that CSEF applications for the 2026 school year will close on the 3<sup>rd</sup> of July, any forms submitted after this date will not be eligible for funding.

CSEF ( Camps, Sports, Excursions Fund ) provides payments to assist eligible families to cover the costs of camps, sporting activities and excursions.

### CSEF Eligibility

Those that are eligible to apply for CSEF are:

- families holding a valid means-tested concession card (parents card, not the child's)
- temporary foster parents

If you are unsure if you are eligible or must re-apply, please don't hesitate to contact the college on 8348 7100 or fill out another CSEF application form and drop this into the front office at your earliest convenience.

Congratulations to the 29 students who have completed the challenge so far!

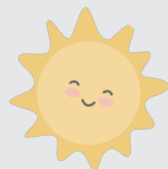
With 114 days still to go, there's plenty of time to keep reading and join our growing group of successful challengers.
