



IMPORTANT UPDATE FOR PREP - YEAR 6 FAMILIES

What is changing?

From the beginning of 2027, Victorian government schools will no longer invite or allow families to purchase or bring a personal digital device for students in Prep to Year 6 to use at school.

What this means for Point Cook College

- Families will not be required to supply a device for students in Prep–Year 6 from 2027.
- The College is planning how school-provided devices will support learning in these year levels.
- The BYOD program for students in Years 7–9 will continue.

What families need to do now

Please do not purchase a new BYOD device for a child who will be in Prep–Year 6 in 2027 specifically for use at school.

No other action is required at this stage. The College will provide further information during 2026 as arrangements for school-provided devices, digital learning and responsible use are finalised.
